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GLO Qatar QA / QC Services for World Biggest GTL Plant

GLO Qatar launched their next prestigious contract for QA/QC services on the US\$ 900 million Gas-To-Liquids (GTL) Project in Ras Laffan, Qatar. When operational in December 2005, the project will be one of the biggest and most technically advanced GTL Plants in the world, which is owned by the JV between Qatar Petroleum and SASOL of South Africa.

GLO Qatar has been appointed for providing almost 20 QA/QC Engineers (all disciplines) to cover the construction activities of the project for which the EPC contractor is Technip Italy S.p.A.

The project will use approximately 330 million cubic feet per day of lean methane rich gas from Qatar's North Gas Field (which has proven reserves exceeding 900 trillion cubic feet) as feedstock to produce 34,000 bpd of liquids (24,000 bpd of diesel, 9,000 bpd of naphtha and 1,000 bpd of liquefied petroleum gas).

Some US\$.1.8 million value is expected for GLO Qatar.
